COMMUNIQUE



COMMUNIQUÉ

Adopted by the Peace and Security Council (PSC) of the African Union (AU) at its 1284th meeting held on 19 June 2025 on Consideration of the Report of the PSC Field Mission to the Republic of Guinea, conducted from 30 to 31 May 2025.

The Peace and Security Council.

Recalling Assembly Decision [Assembly/AU/Dec.868 (XXXVII)] adopted by the 37th Ordinary Session of the Assembly of the Union held on 17-18 February 2024, in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, and also **recalling** Declaration [Ext/Assembly/AU/Decl.(XVI)] on Terrorism and Unconstitutional Changes of Government, adopted by the 16th Extraordinary Session of the AU Assembly of Heads of State and Government held in Malabo, Equatorial Guinea, from 27 to 28 May 2022;

Further recalling the previous decisions and pronouncements pertaining to the situation in the Republic of Guinea, particularly Communiqué [PSC/PR/COMM.1212 (2024)] adopted at its 1212th meeting, held on 20 May 2024;

Noting the opening remarks of H.E. Ambassador Innocent E. Shiyo Permanent Representative of the United Republic of Tanzania to the AU and Chairperson of the PSC of the AU for June 2025, and the presentation of the Report of the PSC Field Mission to the Republic of Guinea by H.E. Ambassador Harold Bundu Saffa, Permanent Representative of the Republic of Sierra Leone to the AU and PSC Chairperson for May 2025; and

Acting under Article 7 of its Protocol, the Peace and Security Council,

1. **Adopts** the report of the AU PSC Field Mission to the Republic of Guinea and its recommendations; and **requests** the AU Commission and relevant stakeholders to ensure the implementation of these recommendations and to provide regular updates to the Council on progress;
2. **Commends** the Transition Authorities for their progress in implementing the Transition Roadmap and urges them to continue honoring the commitments made toward its completion by December 2025, as agreed by the parties;
3. **Reaffirms** the AU's solidarity with the people and the Transition Authorities in Guinea in their commitment to completing the transition process and restoring constitutional order, in accordance with the adopted Transition Roadmap to be finalized by December 2025;
4. **Highlights** the importance of inclusivity in Guinea's political process by involving a broader range of stakeholders, including women and youth, to promote national ownership of the transition, build trust, and incorporate diverse perspectives on governance, human rights, and reconciliation issues;
5. **Requests** the AU Commission to engage the Transition Authorities of Guinea to identify areas of support and provide the needed technical and financial support to Guinea, in particular for the organization of the referendum for the new constitution scheduled for September 2025, as well as the strengthening judicial systems and preparation for the general elections scheduled for December 2025, in line with AU principles and instruments;

6. **Appeals** to the international organizations and bilateral partners to support the Transition Authority of Guinea to ensure a successful conclusion of the transition process and to swiftly return to constitutional order;
7. **Expresses** appreciation to the Transition Authorities and people of the Republic of Guinea for the warm hospitality accorded to the PSC delegation during its mission;
8. **Decides** to remain actively seized of the matter.
